Banyan is actively exploring its AurMac project located 40km north of Mayo.

### **What the Youth Advisor Will Do**

- Provide cultural guidance and advice to Banyan staff and contractors
- Support respectful communication and relationship building between Banyan and the community
- Share land-based knowledge and seasonal considerations (as appropriate and agreed)
- Participate in meetings and occasional site visits (optional)
- Support cultural awareness learning for project staff

### **Who We are Looking For**

- Must be a Citizen of the First Nation of Na-cho Nyäk Dun
- Must be a respected youth and invested in the community well-being
- Interested in supporting land stewardship and respectful engagement
- Able to communicate clearly and respectfully
- Willing to work with Banyan and FNNND in a professional and confidential manner

### **Work Schedule and Compensation**

This position is expected to be part-time and flexible. Work may include meetings, advisory sessions, and optional site visits. Compensation will be based on a part-time role.

The Youth Advisor plays an important role in supporting cultural respect, traditional knowledge awareness, and community-based guidance for exploration activities. This role helps strengthen trust, transparency, and meaningful relationships between Banyan Gold and the FNNND community.
