About This Opportunity

Banyan Gold Corp. is seeking an Environmental Manager to support responsible exploration activities at the AurMac Gold Project. This role is an important leadership position focused on protecting the land, water, wildlife, and environment, and ensuring exploration activities are carried out safely and responsibly.

Banyan is committed to working respectfully within the Traditional Territory of the First Nation of Na-cho Nyäk Dun (FNNND) and to maintaining strong, transparent relationships with the community. FNNND citizens are strongly encouraged to apply.

What the Environmental Manager Will Do

- Lead environmental monitoring, compliance, and stewardship activities for exploration programs
- Support baseline studies (water, wildlife, vegetation, fish, and other environmental programs)
- Ensure exploration work follows permits and environmental protection measures
- Support spill prevention planning and incident response procedures
- Work closely with the Community Relations Manager and Environmental Monitors
- Help ensure environmental information is shared clearly and respectfully with the community
- Coordinate environmental consultants and support reporting requirements
- Supporting environmental assessment and permitting requirements for exploration programs

Who We Are Looking For

- Strong interest in protecting the land and supporting responsible development
- Experience in environmental work, land stewardship, monitoring, or natural resource management
- Ability to work in the field and travel to site as required
- Strong communication skills and ability to work respectfully with community and project teams
- Organized and able to track environmental information and commitments
- Professional, reliable, and committed to safety



Qualifications

Required:

- Post-secondary education or equivalent experience in environmental science, biology, geology, natural resources, or a related field
- Experience in environmental monitoring, compliance, or field-based work (mining or exploration experience is an asset)
- Valid driver's licence
- Willingness to complete required safety and site training

Preferred (but not required):

- Experience working in Yukon and/or within modern treaty settlement lands
- Experience supporting environmental baseline programs or regulatory reporting
- Experience working with consultants or contractors
- Experience supporting YESAB or permitting processes

Why This Role Matters

The Environmental Manager plays an important role in helping ensure exploration activities are carried out responsibly and in a way that respects FNNND values and land stewardship. This role supports transparency, environmental protection, and long-term relationship building.

Work Schedule and Compensation

This is a full-time position based in Mayo or Whitehorse, Yukon. Travel to site will be required during exploration programs. Compensation will be competitive and based on experience. Banyan will support training and professional development where appropriate.
