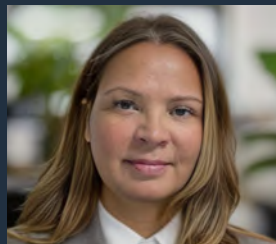

FRANCO-NEVADA PURCHASES EXISTING UNDERLYING NSR ON AURMAC

The recent net-smelter royalty (NSR) acquisition by Franco-Nevada Corporation on a portion of AurMac Project is a strong third-party endorsement of the project's scale and quality, achieved without dilution or operational impact to Banyan Gold Corp. While Banyan does not receive proceeds from the transaction, the \$52 million investment (proceeds paid to PwC, receiver for Eagle gold mine) for exposure to 1%*

of the asset highlights a compelling implied valuation and reinforces the project's long-term potential. For Yukoners and our local community, this type of institutional validation increases confidence that AurMac can advance toward development, strengthening the outlook for future employment, economic opportunities, and sustained investment in the region.

* Banyan has option to reduce the NSR from 6% to 1% for a one-time cash payment of \$10M.
